Moburg named Interim Director of Southern Minnesota AHEC

WILLMAR, Minn. (April 8, 2010) – Rice Memorial Hospital and the Southern Minnesota Area Health Education (AHEC) Board are pleased to announce that Steve Moburg has been named Interim Director of Southern Minnesota AHEC. It is expected that this appointment will be for one year. Southern Minnesota AHEC is part of a collaborative, statewide network managed by the University of Minnesota. It is located at Rice Memorial Hospital, with the director reporting to the AHEC Board of Directors as well as the Chief Administrative Officer at Rice.

As interim director, Moburg will provide administrative leadership for the AHEC, including regional development of a service platform to support health careers promotion, student and resident experiential education, community health awareness and continuing education. A crucial and primary responsibility is developing, implementing and securing the financial sustainability of the AHEC through grant writing and funding source identification.

Moburg began his new position on April 5, 2010. “I have served on the board of another AHEC region and am excited to serve in this new capacity,” said Moburg. “It is our goal to provide opportunities to individuals with the interest in healthcare careers by working with educators and providers in this part of the state, with the ultimate goal in maintaining access to good healthcare in the region.”

Moburg has worked in healthcare administration for thirty years, most recently with Paynesville Area Health Care System. He earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Administration from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa, and his Master of Arts Degree in Health Administration from Georgia State University in Atlanta, Georgia.
